



Methods and Procedure – A phone Interface



Most cameras today can function to detect motion. Much like a baby cam or a security camera, they send out alerts to an app to notify you. But what if you want your personal phone to alert you? With CareRinger, this is possible because the CareRinger check-in call adds the call feature. Thus, one can set a phone to ring when the camera detects motion - Loud and clear, or answer the phone to check in.

It supports land line phones or the internet enabled phones (for someone not using a smart phone).

CareRinger also adds one or more lights to signal the event so it won't be overlooked, and buttons to check in (cancel the alert) if required.

Here is the routine to set up an amazon blink® camera (or other compatible model) for the application

1. Install the blink camera (see blink app for instructions)
2. Add an amazon® routine
3. when: motion detect any time
4. Alexa® will: open the “check on me” skill

Why it works

The camera will detect activity all day long, and call to alert using the “check on me” skill.

To avoid false positive, you may: set motion detect to the time required in your routine. CareRinger will not call to notify you outside the activity hours.
